Introduction

FAROF was mandated to execute a project under the HIV Program by Friend for Global Health Initiatives in Nigeria (FGHIN) "To reduce the risk of HIV infection among OVC and reach at least 2000 OVC with educational materials and other form of care and support services in Birnin Gwari Local Government Area before the end of 2015.

Goal:

To enhance the process of acquiring knowledge, skills, values and attributes for proper mental development, that impacts on the overall wellbeing of the child.

Objectives:

1. Provide Formal education. This is a process of acquiring knowledge and skills with a well-structured curriculum (organized learning process)
2. Provide informal education. This is a process of acquiring knowledge and skills without a well-structured curriculum (no organized learning process)
3. Engage institutions that provide special education and care for children with special needs for instance children with sight, hearing, speech, mental or other disabilities

Target Group

The target groups are orphans and vulnerable children (OVC) between the ages of 1-17years

Background

Education is the staircase out of poverty and orphans and vulnerable children (OVC) are often left at the bottom. Studies have shown that orphaned children and those with sick parents have lower rates of school attendance.

Orphans who had lost both parents were, on average, 17% less likely to attend school than non-orphans. Educational attainment trends downward in countries with generalized HIV epidemics.

On an individual level, OVC who cannot continue education are likely to fall deeper into the cycle of poverty and engage in high-risk behavior, or be exploited by others, which perpetuates the cycle of HIV transmission.

Executive summary

This report presents the implementation of Educational support materials to OVC in Birnin Gwari LGA, core service on this project for Birnin Gwari LGA, Kaduna .

A total of two thousand two hundred and eighty five (2285) **OVC** were enrolled at the end of August 2015. Before the purchase of educational materials, the procurement committee held various meeting to get pro forma invoices from various companies in order to get an affordable and good quality materials to be provided and distributed to OVC in schools, various invoices were submitted by suppliers and a single Company awarded to produce/supply these materials, kindly see attached the minutes of meetings.

Verification Exercise was conducted from 14th of September, 2015 to 17th September, 2015 in Birnin Gwari LGA schools (primary and secondary schools),this verification exercise enables FAROF get a clear picture of real OVC enrolled in school and those entitle for educational support,

The verification exercise conducted in Birnin Gwari LGA helped us to identify the educational needs of the OVC and to improve their livelihood with a view of ensuring the enrolled OVCs in various schools, are provided with educational materials such as books, bags, shoes and other writing materials.

Communities reached

Only Government schools were reached for this exercise, schools present where in the underlisted communities (Birnin Gwari Town,Gayam, Pole waya, Randagi, Magajin Gari, Kungi and Dawakin Bassa) in Birnin Gwari LGA of Kaduna state.

Target population

Orphan and Vulnerable Children OVCs that lost one or either parents.

Verification Report

A team of nine (9) Project community Volunteers (PCVs) were used for the verification exercise, to visit schools and homes using both phone contacted and addresses as specified on the OVC assessment form issued out, it was discovered that a lot of OVCs enrolled in the month of May- June 2015 were not really Orphans but where vulnerable due to poor parents who cannot provide for their homes and families. Thus classified not eligible for educational material for this year 2015

The CEO of FAROF, Ambassador Eunice Adams took it as a duty to visit Selected Schools during the educational materials distribution to hand pick children that are Orphan(double orphan's, single orphan and disabled) are the first to be considered to be given educational materials before giving to other Vulnerable children of poor care givers.

During visit to schools by FAROF Staffs and PCV, it was discovered that 12% are likely to be present in classes, PCV's had to go home visit for follow up and counsel care givers on the important of Children attending schools, despite their various complains on not having the resources to send their children to school, PCVs promised to provide the educational materials for their children through FAROF/FGHIN educational Support project.

All OVC listed in the month of May-June 2015 where thoroughly checked and verified, a total of 247 enrolled OVCs where cancelled and replaced with verified and newly enrolled OVCs.

A total of two thousand, one hundred and twenty five (2125) where successfully verified and recorded in the month of September, 2015.

Advocacy Visits

FAROF carried out various advocacy visits to the Ministry of Education MOE in Birnin Gwari LGA, an escort from MOE was given to FAROF to support and enable FAROF team access schools in the LGA with ease and acceptability, the LGA supported FAROF by providing a focal person who made contacts and provide easy medium to visit community heads and local education authority.

PCVs were set aside as follow up team to monitor children enrolled in school and learning on a continuous basis and keep record for program planning and decision making

Methodology of educational Materials distribution

OVC vulnerability status form (vulnerable children enrollment card) was used to assess each child.

After the verification exercise, the list of OVC enrolled in schools were used and each child provided with educational materials was given hand-to-hand. No one child is allowed to receive for another child who may be absent.

During the educational distribution activity, the wife of the Local Government chairman of Birnin Gwari LGA (Haj. Mariam Ameer) joined Ambassador Eunice Adams and her team in the visit to schools for the distribution of the educational materials to OVCs in schools.

Flag off of Educational Materials distribution

This exercise was flagged off on the 21st September by the Local Government chairman (Alh. Ameer Abdullahi) at the LGA Secretariat chamber, he received the first educational item and flagged the distribution to the first school, LEA primary school Jibrin Maigwari primary school Birnin Gwari central School).

The acting Secretary of the Ministry of Education (MOE) Birnin Gwari LGA (Mr. Aminu S. Abe) promised to support FAROF in her educational materials distribution outreach.

Result

The following items were distributed to each child in each school (one per child): sandal, Bag, exercise books, a pair of socks, mathematical set, 2pen and general mathematics and English textbook

DISCUSSION OF RESULTS:

This report covers the activities carried out in 13 Government schools, distribution of the educational materials to OVCs was done by Ambassador Eunice Adams who is the CEO of FAROF, The educational materials for each school needs includes exercise books, mathematical set, text books, bags, pens, rulers and school sandals. 35 OVCs (57.1% of male and 42.9% of female) were given educational support at LGEA Primary school Gayam, between the ages of 1-14 years.

31 OVCs (54.8% of male and 45.2% of female) were given educational support at LGEA Primary school Pole Waya, between the ages of 1-14 years.

8 OVCs (percentage of male is 100% and female 0%) were given educational support at Government Junior Secondary school Birnin Gwari, between the ages of 1-17 years.

63 OVCs (54% of male and 46% of female) were given educational support at LGEA Jibrin mai gwari primary school, between the ages of 1-14 years.

28 OVCs (60.7% of male and 39.3% of female) were given educational support at Tudun Jega primary school, between the ages of 1-14 years.

19 OVCs (42.1% of male and 57.9% of female) were given educational support at UBE Unguwan Haruna Danzuru primary school , between the ages of 1-14 years.

31 OVCs (64.5% of male and 35.5% of female) were given educational support at LGEA Unguwan Fari primary school , between the ages of 1-14 years.

46 OVCs (47.8% of male and 52.2% of female) were given educational support at Bagoma primary school , between the ages of 1-14 years.

29 OVCs (51.7% of male and 48.3% of female) were given educational support at LGEA primary school Dawaki Bassa , between the ages of 1-14 years.

45 OVCs (55.6% of male and 44.4% of female) were given educational support at Sarkin yaki primary school, between the ages of 1-14 years.

23 OVCs (47.8% of male and 52.2% of female) were given educational support at LGEA primary school kunki Daji, between the ages of 1-14 years.

17 OVCs (76.5% of male and 23.5% of female) were given educational support at LGEA primary school Randagi , between the ages of 1-14 years.

FAROF child protection committee ensures that the protection of the children was secured. During this exercise it was discovered that there is a high number of Vulnerable Children in the LGA.

Challenges

- Could not reach out to more children due to limited resources, thus Educational materials could not reach other Orphans as the number of Orphans in need are 10 times greater than the educational materials available for distribution.
- Falsification of OVC list collected from OVC committee set in Birnin Gwari LGA
- Financial constrain through transport fare for verification and distribution exercise.
- Delay in the disbursement of cash to FAROF/FGHIN account to execute activities made actualizing target date a big challenge.

Success Stories

1. Provided 400 educational materials to OVC in schools in Birnin Gwari LGA.
2. 13 Government schools where reached with educational materials
3. Verification exercise helped to identify real OVC and falsification of OVC list was prevented.
4. Children were very happy and prayed openly for both FAROF/FGHIN
5. Teachers where glad for this supports provided
6. LGA chairman was happy for this support and issued FAROF a letter of recommendation
7. Ministry of Education Birnin Gwari LGA where supportive towards the success of this educational project and offered FAROF a letter of recommendation.

Recommendation

- On time cash advance should be deposited into FAROF/FGHIN account

The meeting commences at 3pm with an opening prayers by Mercy Malik,

Ambassador Eunice Adams announces to all staffs on the importance of a procurement committee in an Organization, she also notify all that names has been hand picked by her on who are the members of this committee, these set committees will include:

Nurudeen jimoh (accountant)

Mercy Malik (Program officer)

She also emphasis on the understanding of both FAROF procurement guideline and FGHIN procurement guide line to be understood, in which from FAROF procurement Guideline a committee will be effective for any amount more the sum of one hundred thousand naira only (N100, 000) required to purchase any item for an activity.

Ambassador Eunice, also told the committee on the effectiveness of the income generating activity (IGA) activities and the need to also know the companies an d prices of items to be used for ICG during that time of the activity.

Nurudeen jimoh, appreciated Ambassador Eunice and told all members present that, the procurement team selected will have to be effective, and the need for an accurate quotation and bidding should be taken very serious and kin at heart.

Adams Michael, also added that the three man procurement committee will have to visit various companies in relation to the educational support materials to find out price and quality, this companies will include shoe and bag production company, printing companies and carry out other market survey as required.

He added that an agreed deadline should be set for the return of price quotaions of the items to be surveyed.

It was concluded that three (3) companies should be visited by the procurement committee and submit an invoice of the companies specifying their prices for all educational materials (shoes, bags, books, sucks, stationaries) per child.

Also Ambassador Eunice told the Adams Michael to reach out to FAROF business Consultant to send a business plan in relation to IGA for tailoring skill and unisex saloon for 15 care givers.

A dead line was fixed by Ambassador Eunice, for all invoices on educational materials to be submitted on or before 15th July, 2015.

The meeting was Adjourned for 15th of August, 10am by Adams Michael and seconded by Murtala Muhammed.

The meeting was concluded at 5.05pm with a Closing prayer carried out by Abubakar Yashau.

The meeting commences at 10.09am with an opening prayers by Mercy Malik,

All pro-forma invoices submitted by suppliers where discussed, price and quality of products were put into consideration, the companies that submitted invoices includes:

- 1. For shoe and bags production**
 - a. Temitope Ekundayo
 - b. Fogo leather works
 - c. Topsy shoes
- 2. For production of books**
 - a. Hafiz Ventures
 - b. Moral printing press
 - c. P & T ventures Nig.

3. For the supply of stationaries

- a. Dominion Samuel Ventures
- b. E.E Ejidike Stationary Stores
- c. Chi-Bes interbiz

Adams Michael suggested that for standard quality and good price, Temitope Ekundayo shoe and bag company should be use and Dominion Samuel Ventures should also be patronize for stationaries, also P & T Ventures Nig. Should be hired for the production of the note books .

Nurudeen jimoh concurred to the suggestion of Adams Michael and so did Mercy Malik.

Thus an agreement was reached upon to purchase all the educational items from Temitope Ekundayo, Dominion Venture and P & T Ventures Nig. respectively after a long time consideration and analysis.

In conclusion, Nurudeen Jimoh advised that since the need of educational material for OVCs is on greater percentage, funds can be scrutinized from activities that are pending and can be carried out at a later time, thus funds from IGA and other possible activities that can be carried out later should be inculcated into the educational materials in other to affect greater number of OVC s in schools.

A review of the project budget was done during the course of the meeting and it was discovered that IGA funds, OVC vocational enrollment, and other sources be looked into support the educational project.

It was agreed that the accountant, should review the budget and analyze what activities funds can be transferred into education since there is a high need of educational materials for OVC in school,

Mercy Malik reminded the committee that base on the Budget available only a total of 400 OVC can be provided with educational materials and the increase rate of US dollars will affect the market price of goods.

She also advised that funds should be disburse immediately as time is not on the side of the project and school resumption is at the corner and that the only person who submitted invoice for supply of socks was Innoson and brothers.

It was agreed for Innoson and brothers to make supply of socks for the educational project.

The meeting was concluded at 1.55pm with a closing prayer by Adams Michael.

Success Story of meeting

1. An agreed date was reached for all invoices to be submitted
2. Highest quality supplier is considered
3. 400 OVCs can be reached with educational support
4. Textbooks will be distributed
5. All suppliers showed interest of project collaboration through the submission of invoices.
6. Other medium of getting funds was discussed and a high percentage of getting addition funds was on a positive ends.

Challenges

1. Limited funds to produce educational materials.
2. Rise in increase rate of dollars caused an increased in the rate of educational materials purchase/production.

Recommendation

Other available ways of getting funds to support the educational project should be considered.
